- Lights and player fee assessments collected for the City of Reno and get remitted directly to them.
- Field Improvements- Requests were solicited from membership and most of the requests were granted.
- The Board and City of Reno met to discuss improving current field conditions. Proposed to the City:
 - ❖ Pledge \$180,000 for field maintenance equipment, contingent council approval of Mr. Ullyot's plan presented to RYSA on 12/5/2023.

- ❖ Pre-pay to the City of Reno Parks Department \$50,000 for restroom maintenance and cleaning for calendar year 2024 for which the 10 bathrooms RYSA currently contracts. Currently RYSA pay a contractor for this service.
- ♦ Increase player fee to 2025 to \$4.00, 2026 to \$5.00 and 2027 to \$6.00.
- Field moving move from contractor to the City of Reno Parks department.
- Improved quality of mowing, mowing twice a week and increased fertilization.

• Steve Bemus- Clarify that money for the mowing program is a pledge. It is a contingent on the City Council passing a budget request for a mowing program.

 - Inclement weather field closures will be issued at approximately noon the day of a weather event.
 - Please do not use fields when conditions are poor, and respect closures.
- Access
 - Contact us if you need keys, do not cut locks.
 - City does not control WCSD locks, best we can do is call the school the next day.
 - If we have someone on staff, we can come unlock, please call 775-352-4249.
 - Field lights.... please turn off each night. Call backs may result in loss of privilege.
- Conditions/Repairs/Issues
 - Please contact us if you notice an issue. Do not expect City staff to notice.
 - ❖ If you want to make repairs yourself, contact me/fill out request form.
 - Let us know in advance of field day/clean-ups, especially if you are going to have debris that needs to be picked up.
 - ❖ Infields are responsibility of league, outfields responsibility of City of Reno
 - ❖ If irrigation coordination is needed, please be proactive.

- Litter and Trash it is each league's and coach's responsibility to clean up after themselves each night, which includes picking up after spectators. Field preparation debris does not go in trash, please haul it off.
- Mowing
 - New contractor this year, please be patient.
 - Likely two mows per week for game fields and some practice fields
- Field updates
 - O'Brien fields open for spring use
 - Mayor's flat field scheduled for fall season.

Mowing Contract-

- Due to procurement time, can not take mowing in house this year
- Contract our for 2024
- Issued RFP and received new bids for 2024 mowing contract. New RFP has second mowing for game sites, not practice site. 40-50 sites get second mowing in 2024.
- Parks Department making a budget request for mowing equipment and personnel of approximately \$1,000,000 for budget. If passed it would commence March of 2025.
